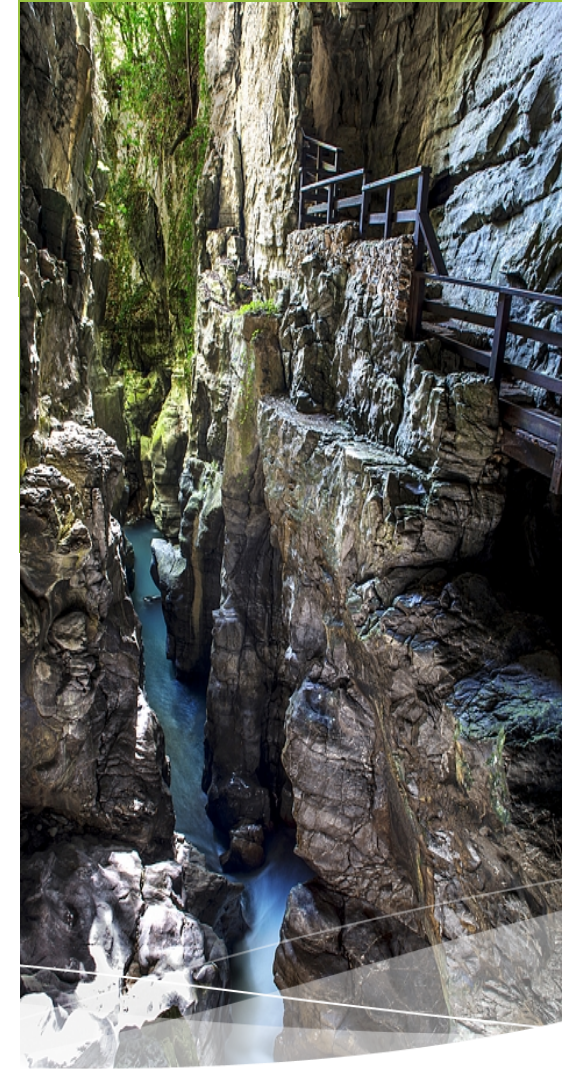


# WWF OASIS

It rises from the southern slope of the Cervati mountain, in the proximity of Caselle in Pittari plunges into a colossal sinkhole to then reemerge, after traversing its mysterious voyage into the bowels of the earth, just kilometers more south, under the inhabited Morigerati. The entire zone offers one of the most beautiful spectacles and of the major natural lures of the Park. The walk starts from Morigerati with a beautiful muletrack paved with stones and in some parts excavated into the rock which,



after a serious of bends going downhill, takes all the way to the entrance of the cave. From here you access through narrow little stairs in stones and overcome the deep and spectacular canyon, excavated from the river, with two tiny wooden bridges. At the outside, then, the river offers suggestive sights along the gorge, where fresh and limpid waters give shape, streaming through deep and evocative wells, to rushes and cascades.



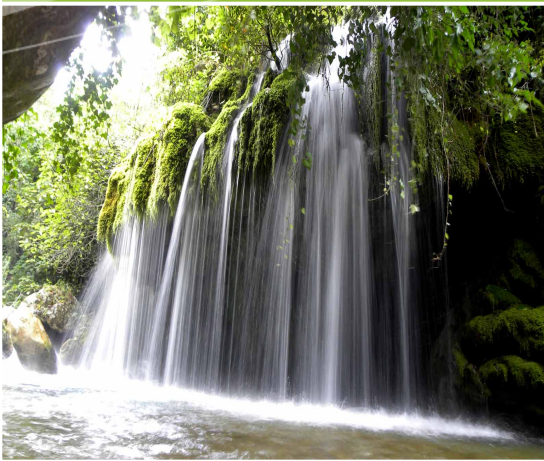

# River Bussento

The river Bussento is the fundamental element which characterizes and imprints significantly the land manifesting itself as one of the major prodigies from the environmental and landscape point of view; also the subterranean trait of the Bussento generates one of the karst phenomenon of greatest importance present in Italy.



The Oasis is the most important preservation project of the WWF Italia and represents the concrete defense of the natural territory and the biodiversity. The inhabited town rests on the summit of a cliff dominating the WWF Oasis of Morigerati, in which we can admire marvelous resurgences of the river Bussento. It is endowed with a natural route and an area equipped for the visit to the caves. The WWF decided to equip the natural trails in order for everybody to appreciate and take fully delight of the natural habitat, offering inducement for all the senses. Particular foreshortenings, with the realization of little resting areas which offer the possibility to observe the animals in a state of tranquility for either the visitors and them.

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
